Mark Moore is President of Access National Bank, a full-service community bank based in Reston, Virginia with assets of \$2.7B, that is the primary subsidiary of parent company Access National Corporation (NASDAQ-listed : “ANCX”). Moore’s career has spanned over 30 years, the vast majority of which has centered on providing premier commercial banking, lending and investment banking services to local enterprises within the Washington DC marketplace. Core market segments have always featured the government contracting and technology sectors.

At The Northern VA Chamber of Commerce, Moore has served on the Board of Directors and its Executive Committee for more than a decade, and was Chairman of the Board in 2013-14. Over the years he has held a wide variety of positions, including Chair of the GovCon Council, Treasurer and Vice Chair, and Chair of Innovations. Moore was a Co-Founder of SECAF (Small Emerging Contractors Advisory Forum) and has served in most leadership roles since its beginning, including as Chairman of the Board and as a 9-time returning Co-Chair of the annual SECAF Awards Gala. Among other business and civic outreach interests, Moore Leadership Fairfax’s Class of 2000 (and

subsequently served on its Board), and the Advisory Board of Virginia Tech's Pamplin College of Business Finance Department (Vice Chairman 2015-present).
