Kevin Reynolds is a member of the executive management committee of Cardinal Financial Corporation, a \$3.28 billion publicly traded financial services company headquartered in Northern Virginia. Before joining a select group of community bankers to establish Cardinal in 1998, Reynolds held executive and management positions with several leading area financial institutions, including George Mason Bank, American Security Bank and the National Bank of Washington.

Reynolds' volunteer efforts, business expertise, and hands-on support have helped organizations throughout the area raise funds and awareness for their causes. His contributions have made a difference to organizations as diverse as the American Heart Association, the City of Fairfax Renaissance Housing Corporation, Rotary International, The Gladney Center for Adoption, Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, Special Olympics, Homestretch and The Martin Luther King, Jr. Cultural Foundation. He serves as Chairman of the Cardinal Bank Charity Classic, Cardinal's signature event, which has raised over \$4 million to benefit Inova Kellar Center and the Cardinal Bank Community Fund.

Reynolds' contributions towards improving the quality of life in the region are widely recognized and reflect his years of service and dedication. He was recently elected Board Chairman of the Fairfax 2015 World Police & Fire Games, the second largest multi-sport event in the world, surpassed only by the Summer Olympic Games, which will be held in the summer of 2015. He was awarded the 2012 Tysons Regional Chamber of Commerce *Executive of the Year for Large Businesses*, and was a finalist for the 2012 Fairfax County Chamber of Commerce *Executive Leader of the Year*. Reynolds was named the 2010 *Business Citizen of the Year* by the Greater McLean Chamber of Commerce, and was honored by the Association of Fundraising Professionals in 2009 as one of Washington's most outstanding fundraising volunteers. That same year, he was honored by Leadership Fairfax with a Regional Leadership Award for fundraising leadership.

Reynolds is a former chairman of the Fairfax County Chamber of Commerce, and is currently serving a four-year appointment to the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors Economic Advisory Commission, as well as on the Advisory Board of the George Mason University School of Management.

A graduate of The College of William and Mary, Reynolds earned an MBA in Finance/Business from George Washington University. He lives in Oakton, Virginia with his wife, Stacey, their two children, and two golden retrievers.
