Tracey M. White serves as the Vice President of Community and Government Relations for Reston Hospital Center, the Hospital Corporation of America (HCA) Capital Division, which covers four states: Virginia, New Hampshire, Kentucky and Indiana, and the HCA Virginia Health System. She has held this position since 2006 and serves as the primary liaison for the HCA facilities to community, government and civic entities. She manages the HCA Virginia Government Relations Team, Good Government Group Virginia – HCA Virginia’s grassroots employee advocacy and education program, and the HCA for Good Government Virginia PAC. In addition, she assists with development projects in including the expansion of Reston Hospital Center and the development of StoneSprings Hospital Center in Loudoun County.

Prior to joining HCA, she served for eleven years as the President & CEO of the Greater Reston Chamber of Commerce.
